

HOW TO GET TO THE 4C LONDON OFFICE

Our Fountain House office is easily accessible by a number of transport connections.

BY NATIONAL RAIL

Fenchurch Street, Cannon Street, London Liverpool Street or London Bridge.

The closest stations to our office are listed above. Both Cannon Street and London Bridge are served by underground lines, as well as National Rail.

Fenchurch Street is located in the south-eastern corner of the City of London and connects with stations in East London and South Essex operated by the c2c rail network. (4-minute walk).

Cannon Street is based in the City of London and connects with stations on the Southeastern Railway main line and serves customers based in Southeast London and Kent. (10-minute walk).

London Liverpool Street is located in the north-eastern part of the City of London and services a number of railway networks – c2c, Greater Anglia, Stansted Express, London Overground and TfL Rail. Liverpool Street connects with Cambridge, Norwich, destinations in the East of England and Stansted and Southend Airports. (15-minute walk).

London Bridge Station is located immediately south of London Bridge, it caters for customers heading to or from locations in southeast London, Kent and East Sussex and is served by Southeastern Railway and Thameslink services.

Thameslink services connect London Bridge Station to Bedford, Cambridge, Peterborough, Brighton and other destinations in Sussex and Kent. The Thameslink route also provides a connection to Gatwick Airport, Luton Airport and Crossrail. (14-minute walk).

BY OVERGROUND

London Liverpool Street

You can reach London Liverpool Street by London Overground. (15-minute walk).

BY UNDERGROUND

Bank, Monument, Aldgate and Liverpool Street

Our office is surrounded by a number of underground stations that accommodate many underground lines. (Please note that Bank and Monument are interconnected). Please find details of which lines service these stations below.

Bank – Waterloo & City, Central and Northern (8-minute walk).

Monument – Circle and District (6-minute walk).

Aldgate – Circle and Metropolitan (7-minute walk).

Liverpool Street – Central, Circle, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan (15-minute walk).

BY DLR

Tower Gateway and Bank

The closest DLR stations to our office are Tower Gateway (10-minute walk) and Bank (8-minute walk).

BY RIVER BUS

Tower Pier (7-minute walk) and London Bridge (14-minute walk)

The mbna Thames Clipper run every twenty minutes and is a great way to avoid traffic and tube tunnels.

BY PRIVATE TRANSPORT

No on-site parking.

Unfortunately, we don't offer on-site parking. However, if you would like to drive to our office there is a car park located at the below address. The Minories car park is approximately 12 minutes from our office by foot.

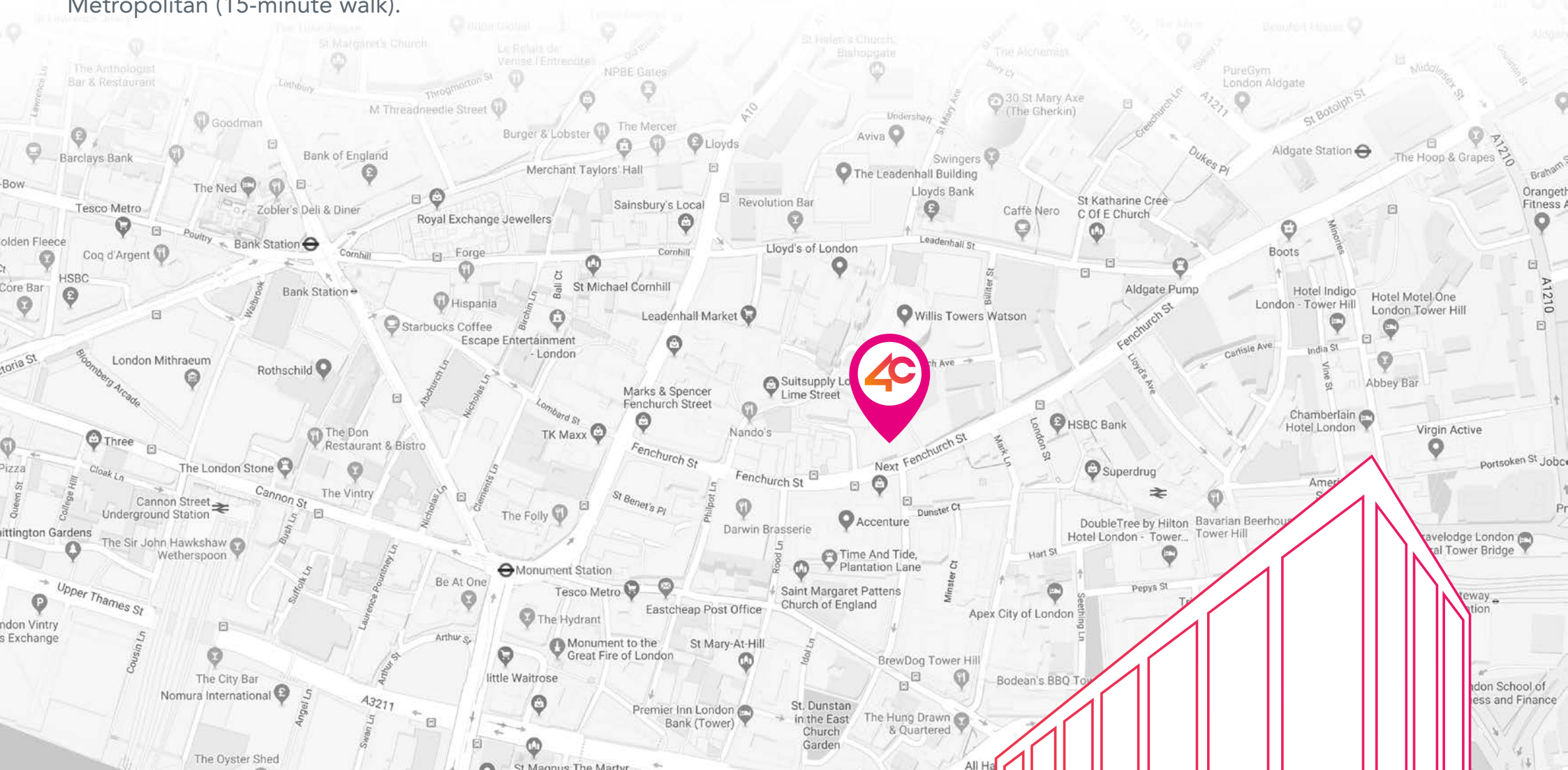
Tower Hill Apartments are a great option for those booking accommodation for a longer stay.
